



# 2011-12 BOARD GOALS

## GOAL #1

### **STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT GOAL: Continue to Increase Student Achievement in the areas of READING and MATH**

1. Teams of teachers and administrators (Data Retreat Teams) will review student achievement results at each building in the areas of reading and math.
2. The Data Retreat Teams will identify areas of strength to be maintained.
3. The Data Retreat Teams will identify achievement gaps and develop a plan to address these gaps.
4. Each Data Retreat Team will:
  - a. Develop a Building Action Plan with measurable goals in the area of reading and math;
  - b. Develop specific procedures and methods to achieve goals;
  - c. Include common building procedures designed to promote student achievement and an orderly environment. These procedures will build a common thread across the district.
5. The Action Plans will be shared with each building at the opening in-service.
6. Each building will develop a monitoring system to insure the Action Plans are being implemented by staff.
7. Principals will provide updates to the Board of Education as needed.
8. Principals will report out results before the 2012-13 school year starts.
9. District and building in-services will support the building plans throughout the school year.

## GOAL #2

### **GRADUATION RATE: Increase High School Graduation Rate**

1. Two Rivers High School will have a graduation rate of 90% or greater.
2. The High School Principal and High School Leadership Team (Graduation Committee) will identify issues that are preventing students from graduating.
3. The Graduation Committee will develop plans to address the issues preventing students from graduating and report to the Board of Education these recommendations.
4. The Graduation Committee will provide semester updates to the Board of Education on program implementation.

## GOAL #3

### **The Two Rivers School District will work with the City of Two Rivers to implement the grant to build the Bike Trail to Two Rivers High School.**

1. The District Administrator will work with the City Manager to insure the bike trail will be completed in the best interests of the students and community.
2. The District Administrator will meet with the City Manager monthly and provide the Board of Education and community with regular updates.
