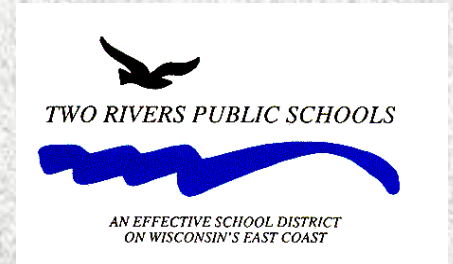

Literacy Goal

We, the elementary educators of the Two Rivers Public School District, will improve reading comprehension in the area of analyzing text, evaluating and extending meaning so 80% of our non-SwD and 65 % of our SwD are proficient or above on their grade level assessment and are proficient or above on the NWEA-MAP assessment by May 2011.

Action Plan:

- Teachers will have students document their progress on a growth card after each NWEA-MAP assessment.
- Parents will be provided with quarterly assessments of their child.
- Parents will be provided with teacher e-mail addresses to increase communication on their child's progress.
- Parents will be informed of grade level reading expectations and exit criteria using grade level brochures at our beginning of the school reading assessments.
- Teachers will implement before and after school programs to supplement classroom instruction.
- Teachers will hold "Spaghetti for Success" nights for parents and students. Reading strategies (K-2) and effective test taking strategies (3-4) will be shared.
- Teachers will hold a motivational Reading Week.
- Teachers will work with families to support parents with ideas to help their child with comprehension strategies.

Math Goal

We, the elementary educators of the Two Rivers Public School District, will ensure that 75% of Non SwD students and 75% of SwD students will demonstrate mastery of basic math facts and proficiency in applying those basic math facts as measured by a district developed assessment. 75% of Non SwD and 60% of SwD will demonstrate proficiency in math processes and number operations on the NWEA MAPs by May 2011.

Action Plan:

- Students will study basic math facts for at least 10 minutes after school hours.
- Teachers will share the mathematical proficiency of their students using NWEA-MAP (K-4) and classroom-based assessments (PreK-4).
- Teachers will have students document their progress on a growth card after each NWEA-MAP assessment.
- Parents will be provided with quarterly assessments of their child.
- Parents will be provided with teacher e-mail addresses to increase communication on their child's progress.
- Teachers will create a math rich culture by providing opportunities for math fact assessment and show evidence of math learning in every classroom.
- Teachers will hold "Spaghetti for Success" nights for parents and students. Simple techniques for learning math facts will be shared.
- Every child will have access to math fact flashcards for home study.
- Teachers will work with families to support parents with ideas to help their child with comprehension strategies.
