MISSION STATEMENT

The Educational Horizons Foundation, Inc. is an independent organization dedicated to the enhancement of educational opportunities of the participants in and the alumni of the Two Rivers Public School District.

FOUNDATION STRUCTURE

The **Executive Committee** is composed of the four officers of the Board of Directors. It is this committee's function to call meetings of the Board, plan for the Foundation, and be responsible for the financial management of the Foundation's funds including investment and allocation of the funds for distribution by the Disbursement and Allocations Committee. The committee allocates funds to a general endowment fund, a restricted fund, or an unrestricted fund. Some of these

allocations are determined by the donor; however, where there are options available, the Executive Committee makes the recommendation.

The **Community Relations and Development Committee** is responsible for fund raising activities, marketing, alumni relations, and media relations. The committee plans fund raising that includes receipt of gifts from individuals/alumni, corporations/businesses, as well as other

foundations.

The **Disbursement and Allocation Committee** is responsible for making recommendations to the Board regarding specific disbursements as provide Secondary Article Heading provided through general guidance from the Executive Committee. Disbursements include student scholarships, staff development activities, capital requests (building and/or equipment), and program support.

SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENT

As a senior at Washington High School I was awarded the Warren Otto scholarship from the Educational Horizons Foundation, Inc. 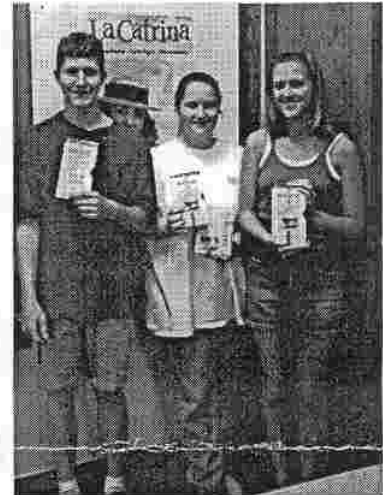

LANGUAGE TAPES

The mission of the Educational Horizons Foundation, Inc. is to enhance educational opportunities of participants and the alumni of the Two Rivers Public School District. Funds received from contributors which are not directly earmarked for scholarships are distributed by the foundation board upon recommendation by the Disbursement and Allocation Committee. Teachers, students and community members may apply for and Educational Horizon's grant. In the Spring of 1999 the Educational Horizons Board approved a grant to the

Washington High School Foreign Language Department for \$1,167.90 to purchase French and Spanish multimedia programs. The videos and learning packages will create an authentic immersion experience for Washington High School foreign language students helping to develop their listening, speaking, reading and writing skills. Filmed on location with native actors in French and Spanish speaking throughout the world, the videos not only build language skills but cultural understanding.



Activities and Programs

Funds raised are a vehicle for obtaining resources to support educational initiatives not funded by regular revenue sources. The endowment of funds is the primary supportive vehicle for accomplishing the activities of the foundation such as:

- scholarships to post secondary educational institutions
- supportive grants for students for extended year or program educational experiences
- grants for teachers for projects which enhance classroom instruction and learning
- expose and prepare students for the technological economy
- expand upon the fine arts programs of the schools
- provide resources for additional before and after school activities for disabled students, as well as gifted and talented
- development of cultural, scientific, and environmental programs
