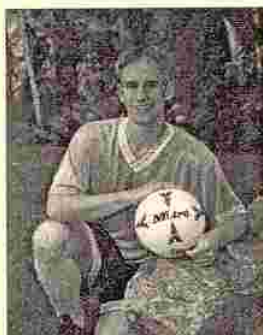

Educational Enhancement for the High School Media Center

In April 2000, Educational Horizons allocated \$3,182 to fund a technology project at Washington High School. The grant, written by Virginia Pohlman and David Roloff, will introduce video-editing capabilities to the Information Media Center that will be available to all WHS students. The funding was used to purchase two digital video camcorders, as well as video-editing software, and other technological upgrades as necessary to record, edit, and produce professional-level video projects.

The components purchased will be installed shortly, and current plans call for students to put the new technology to work by the end of the first semester.
