New Two Rivers High School Welcomes Students

A new era in learning for students in Two Rivers has begun. The doors of the new Two Rivers High School opened at the beginning of the 2002-03 school year. In addition, an Open House and Dedication Ceremony were held on Sunday, November 3, 2002.

Features of this new state-of-the-art building include larger Science labs and classrooms, which include the latest in safety and ventilation. Teachers in the areas of Math, Language, Social Studies and Special Education now have their own individual classrooms in order to provide the best learning environment for students. The Fine Arts areas of the building include appropriately-sized and acoustically sound band and chorus rooms with soundproof practice rooms. Students in the Industrial Arts, Business Education, Family/Consumer Education and Foreign Language areas have modern equipment and

technology upgrades, as well as applied learning labs. The new library contains a computerized resource center and computer lab for student use in addition to audiovisual labs and appropriate book space. The Cafetorium has a seating capacity of 600 for lunch and 800 for plays and programs. This area comes with a complete lighting and sound system.

The Educational Horizons Foundation has played an integral part in making this facility one to be proud of. The Foundation donated a total of \$213,395.46 to the new high school, which was used for classroom enlargements and enhancements. 2002 Scholarships and Grants Awarded

Recent years have seen grants used to purchase foreign language tapes, video camcorders, video editing software and computers.
